

Workhorse W-Series - Power Steering Fluid - Filter Change

- ① Remove the reservoir cap
- ② Remove the large diameter hose from the base of the reservoir to drain fluid.
- ③ Place drain pan below reservoir.
- ④ Once fluid is drained, remove the clamp from the reservoir lid, and remove the lid.
- ⑤ Reach into the reservoir with your filter socket (or filter strap tool) and remove the old filter by turning it counter clockwise until it comes loose from the threads.
- ⑥ Install the new filter by hand by turning it clockwise to tighten it. Tighten it 1/2 turn after the seal makes contact with the reservoir.
- ⑦ Reinstall the hose onto the reservoir base.
- ⑧ Reinstall the reservoir lid and tighten the clamp.
- ⑨ Fill reservoir with power steering fluid.
- ⑩ Run engine while pressing brake pedal repeatedly and turning steering wheel for about 1 minute.

⑪ Shut off engine, and top off fluid.

⑫ Reinstall the reservoir cap.
